

Learning in Sowenna Class

A typical day in Sowenna:

- ▶ **9.15am -9.30am** Arrival at school - practicing our independence skills e.g. unpacking our bags, hanging our coats up, putting our pack lunches/snacks on to lunch trolley, toileting, etc.
- ▶ **9.30am- 9.45am** Key skills with a focus on subsidizing and recognising numbers, followed by our good morning routine and weather report.
- ▶ **9.45am - 10.15am** Phonics as a whole class looking at our sound/letter of the day using visuals, symbols and rhyme. Handwriting targets set out by individual assessment.
- ▶ **10.15am -10.30am** Snack time with a specific look at independent skills.
- ▶ **10.30am -11.00am** Leisure time indoors and outdoors (weather permitted) and personal care with a key focus on outdoor learning targets.
- ▶ **11.00-11:45am** Core subject learning with a focus on numeracy and literacy based on the terms focus and sequence of learning.
- ▶ **12.00pm -1.15pm** Lunch, Leisure Time (indoor & outdoor) & Personal Care.
- ▶ **1.15pm – 1.30pm** "Dough Disco" looking at fine motor skills and getting our fingers ready for topic-based learning.
- ▶ **1.30pm – 1:45pm** Word of the week where we look at a word and the phonic understanding to blend and segment the word. We then look to spell it by the end of the week independently
- ▶ **1:45pm - 2.45pm** Topic based sessions (2) within another area of the curriculum. With a focus on our enrichment and creative arts curriculum.
- ▶ **2.45pm - 3.15pm** Snack and Personal care, celebrating the days learning.
- ▶ **3.15pm – 3.30pm** Story time and brush our teeth before we go home song.
- ▶ *NB: Pupil IEP targets and National Curriculum assessments are woven throughout the range of activities experienced each day*
