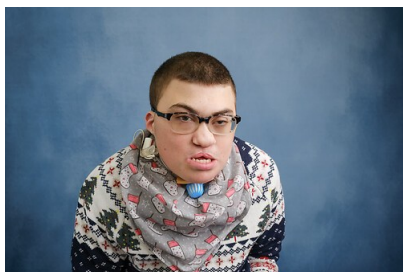


Curnow School Newsletter

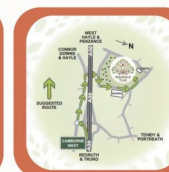
