Our topic is Weather. We have been outside to experience different kinds of weather.

We enjoy lots of sensory experiences outside. We listen to different sounds; lots of us love listening to birds, we smell the herbs, look at the flowers and touch different plants and materials





We love using the Resonance boards





Resonance boards provide tactile and auditory feedback whenever the child moves. When the child kicks the board, there is a sound and a vibration. This feedback encourages the child to repeat the movement, and eventually to experiment with other movements as well. The child moves independently, without an adult manipulating his or her body. Sounds created by the child's movements resonate from the wood. This immediate feedback can help the brain integrate motor activity and listening skills.











We really enjoy 'chatting' with our friends. At different times during the day







Everyday we have 'Talking time'. This is where we sit in a circle without any adults. We are left to 'chat' with each other. Some of the class prefer to listen to their friends, some are building up their confidence to join in others are learning to take turns and not vocalise loudly over their friends.

Liddy, Jarome and Alfie were flying the flag high for Post 16, enjoying the night, helping to pick raffle tickets and making everyone feel welcome.






Pat and Carole did an amazing job of BINGO calling. We all had lots of fun. Thank you for giving your time to support us.

Egg hunts are the perfect opportunity to use and practice positional language—on, in, under, behind, in front.

Attached to this are two core boards to use for egg hunts. You can model them while searching or use them to help your child to tell you what they are doing and what they have enjoyed.



Remember that core words can carry different meaning in different contexts so it is important to practice in different ways and situations.

Core word 'In'

'Let's stay in today', 'come in and play with me'

Hiding objects in boxes and containers to be found, 'what's in here?

Sing Hokey Cokey –'In out in out shake it all about'

Feely bag - 'What's in the bag? Can you take it out?'

Visiting different places, 'let's go in'

Packing a bag to go on an outing— 'what will you put in the bag?'

Cooking—put the eggs in.

Remember that core words can carry different meaning in different contexts so it is important to practice in different ways and situations

Core word 'Out'

'I am ready to go out. I have my mask ready to wear.', 'come out to play with me'

Playing hide and seek or chasing games –'Look out here I come!'

Sing Hokey Cokey –'In out in out shake it all about'

Feely bag - 'What's in the bag? Can you take it out?'


Space – 'what is out there?'


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Easter Egg Hunt Chart
