

Learning in Lamorna Class

A typical day in Lamorna:

- ▶ **9.00am -9.30am** Arrive at school into Circle Time for Communication, Speaking & Listening skills- Preparing for our day ahead- colour and smell of the day- positional changes into physio equipment
- ▶ **9.30am- 10am** Physical development in the hall/classroom with specific learning focus of physical development or dance whilst meeting our physiotherapy targets
- ▶ **10am-10.30am** Snack and Communication session, working on independence and choice making skills including AAC
- ▶ **10.30am-11am** Communication- Speaking and listening 'Hello' circle time- who is at school today?
- ▶ **11.15am-11.30pm** Moonlight room /SI room for movement break and PD/social skills OR phonics 'visual skills' session
- ▶ **11.30pm-12pm** 'Soundbath', relaxation and body awareness
- ▶ **12pm-1.30pm** Lunch and Leisure time (Communication choice making/target's/independence target's/PHSE)
- ▶ **1.30pm-2.15pm** Afternoon topic based, Cognition and learning- Sensory Story, Sensory cooking/ Art, Sensory wake and shake, Massage story, Music
- ▶ **2.30pm – 3pm** Snack (Communication-AAC/ Independence targets & PHSE)
- ▶ **3pm-3.15pm** Celebrate the day's learning with class Assembly, Learning and targets celebrated (RE & SMSC)
- ▶ *NB: Pupil Short term targets and National Curriculum assessments are woven throughout the range of activities experienced each day*
