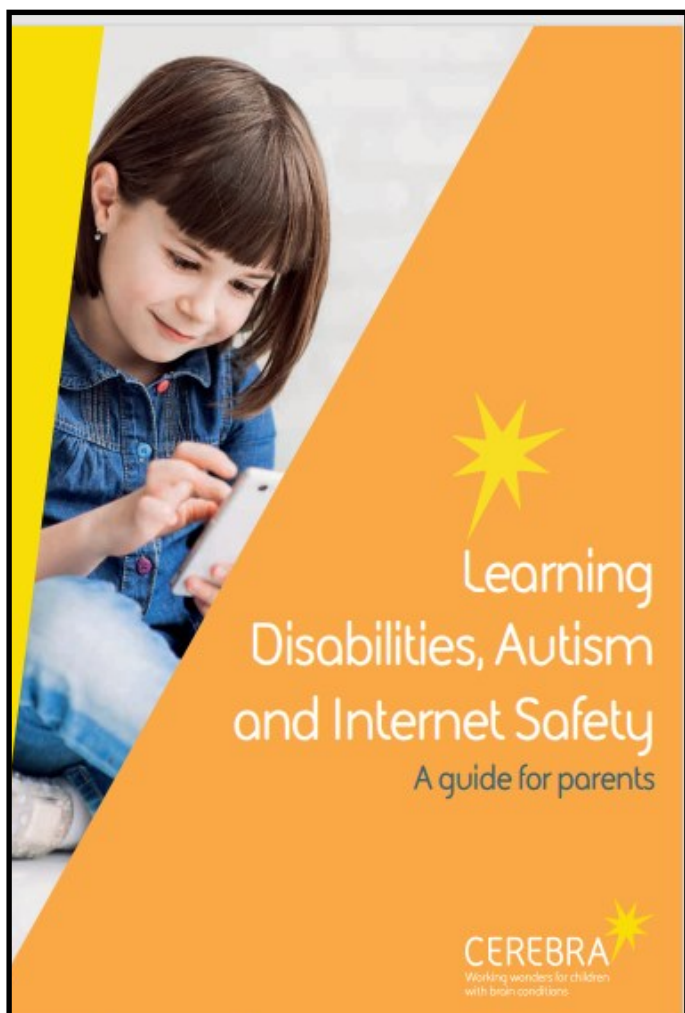


## Keeping your home internet safe
